Gamma Solutions' expertise in the mobile technology industry and its existing relationship with Mitre 10 made it a natural choice when Mitre 10 decided to upgrade its wireless radio frequency system.

"Stock management is reported pretty close to instantaneously now, allowing for quicker responses at a national level from the various merchandise and inventory teams. This in turn allows the Mitre 10 help desk to more accurately answer customer enquiries about orders and product availability" said BlackHawke Marshall.

Mitre 10's legacy inventory management system did not provide access to a real-time record of the locations and specifics of products throughout the nation, with the process often being hampered by the timely process of manually receiving and despatching orders.

Gamma Solutions implemented Radio Frequency solutions for the scanning and printing of labels in different areas of the Mitre 10 supply chain and warehouse environment. "Gamma Solutions was able to specify a variety of wireless handheld solutions for the warehousing of Mitre 10 stock, this included mobile and fixed position barcode scanners. These barcode scanners are able to be used by operators throughout the different Mitre 10 warehouses providing a real-time inventory solution" said Paul Pleming of Gamma Solutions.

"Gamma Solutions has been a long time supplier to Mitre 10 over the past seven years. We have helped them migrate from their older radio frequency technology through to the newer technologies. Providing better information for management to make decisions at a national level enables Mitre 10 to maximize its return on investment" explained Paul Pleming.

Mitre 10's radio frequency technology uses Cisco access points, which are mapped out and designed according to the needs of radio frequency coverage in particular areas of the warehouse. This enables operators access to the national Mitre 10 database with ease. The wireless handheld technology being implemented by Gamma Solutions will assist operators in the picking and receiving of stock, ongoing consolidation, reliable and up to date stock tracking and ongoing inventory checks.

The portable Intermec CK30 handheld computers are able to communicate directly to the various Cisco access points in the warehouses. This data is then sent via a local area network to the Mitre 10 computer system, which enables the company to access a national linkage solution for any of its warehouses nationwide, improving efficiency and enabling real time inventory management.

With a total of 190 Mitre 10 staff in warehouses in Victoria, Western Australia and Queensland utilising the newly installed logistics system, Mitre 10 looks set to continue to be an industry leader in home hardware solutions by capitalising on its investment in stock management. The ongoing use of advanced real time technology throughout its different warehouses will allow for a more superior level of inventory management, which will directly result in benefits to customers nationwide.

Michael Byrne, Mitre 10 National Supply Chain Manager commented "the introduction of radio frequency technology to the stock picking process will see the accuracy levels in those warehouses rise 15%, and with the introduction of other technologies we will continue to see further productivity improvements."

The wireless system introduced by Gamma Solutions supports Mitre 10's expanding role in the hardware market in Australia, resulting in increased productivity in all areas of operation from stock management to customer deliveries
